The prints are made on a dimensionally stable tri-acetate polyester base, essentially a plastic base as opposed to traditional paper base. Since it uses azo dyes on a polyester base, the print will not fade, discolor, or deteriorate for a long time. Characteristics are image clarity, color purity, more environmentally safe, as well as being an archival process able to produce critical accuracy to the original slide.

Artist/photographer Marshall Brines Drew was born in Greenport, NY. An art teacher at Grover Cleveland High School in NYC for 36 years, he was a survivor of the *Titanic* disaster in 1912 when he was only 8 years old. Drew was traveling on the *Titanic* with his aunt and uncle (his foster parents) when the ship sank on its maiden voyage killing 1,513 people – among them his uncle. He and his aunt survived in one of the life boats.
